

Does your child have an

AUTISM SPECTRUM CONDITION?

Cornell University is seeking children with autism spectrum conditions 10 to 15 years of age, and/or their non-autistic brothers or sisters, for a research study examining how autistic social traits (for example difficulty with social responding) and other traits (for example superiority at noticing small details) go together. Participants will spend a couple of hours (with breaks) on some psychological tests, will borrow a laptop computer on which to play an experimental video game at home. They will also have brain waves and MRI scans recorded. Participants must be verbal and high-functioning, and able to sit still in front of a computer. Participants will be paid \$50 for their time, and can keep a copy of the video game for their home computer, as well as MRI pictures of their brains.
